

- Open source software system that enables libraries and archives to provide access to audio and video collections
- Samvera (formerly Hydra) Solution Bundle
- Goals:
 - Easily installable and configurable
 - Serve a variety of use cases and institutions
 - Create a basis for sustainable development
- Currently in production at 10+ institutions
