Why the need?

We both are committed to long-term preservation in the repository but UK universities have a mandate to preserve research data in particular.

Why Archivematica?

Archivematica is a well-respected, open-source tool which seemed to offer much of the functionality we needed.

What we have done?

We have had 3 phases of Jisc project funding, including a feasibility study and work with Archivematica to improve its applicability to research data.
