Samvera is based around four major components:

Community development

- Name and logo change / website
 - Fantastic response to the request for possible new names
 - Getting the name out there - spread the word!
 - Website contributions - all much appreciated
- IG/WG activity
 - Equal numbers of IGs and WGs - continuing discussion, plus action where needed
 - Email lists / slack / wiki / calls
- Key theme - migration from other platforms
 - DSpace, CONTENTdm, BePress discussion
- Training
 - First Advanced Hydra/Samvera Camp (May, Minneapolis), plus first combined Camp with Fedora (September, Oxford)

 - Involvement of community in decision-making and coding
 - Current starting point for rolling your own / key community offering
- Release of Hyku
 - Out of the box instantiation of Hyrax
 - Community involvement, within and beyond formal project partners
 - Hyku beta test program and HykuDirect pilot
 - Exploring models of sustainability
- Avalon developments
 - Hosted service pilot with LYRASIS
 - Move to Hyrax underway

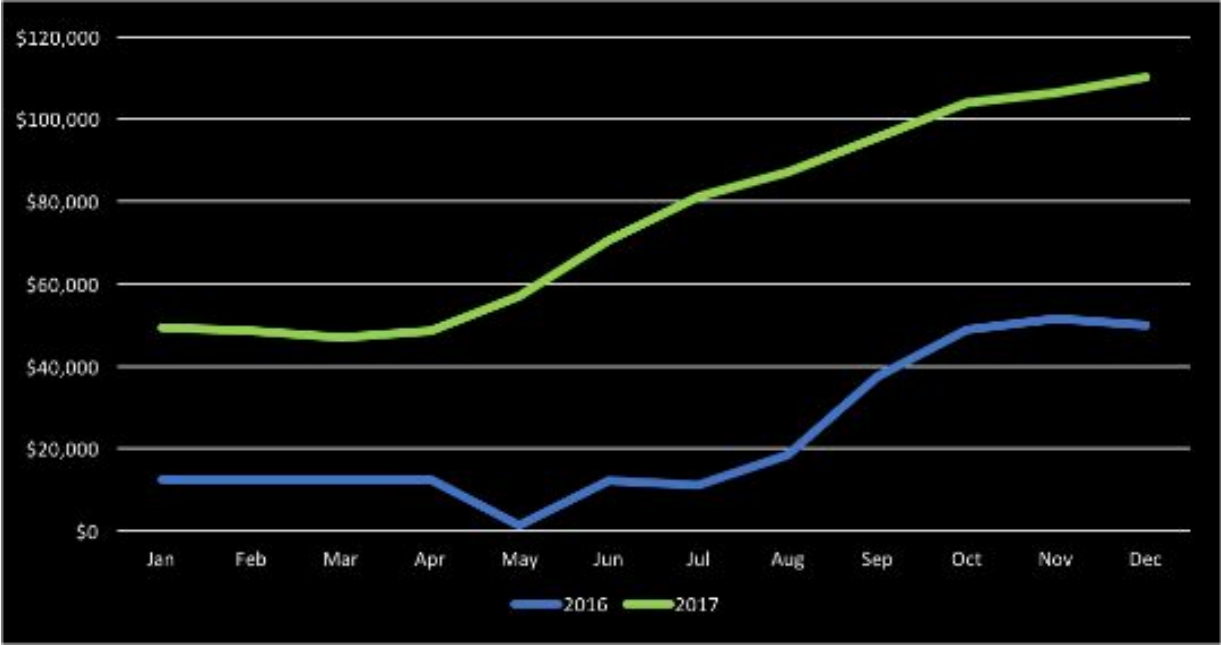
