# Steering's role



- Steering's role is essentially stewardship and central administration
- For today, we can break that down into three parts:
  - Administrative tasks on behalf of Partners
  - Annually repeating tasks
  - Occasional tasks
- Let's take each of those in turn and highlight some key events

### **Admin tasks for Partners**



- New legal documents to reflect the changes brought about by last year's Governance changes
- Putting in place the vote to approve a Charter for the new Roadmap Council and to approve new By-laws for Steering
- Exploring the possibility of short-term seed funding to help accelerate the hiring of at least one staff position — Community Manager or Technical Manager

## **Recurring annual events**



- Negotiate Memorandum of Understanding with our fiscal sponsor, DuraSpace, for 2019
  - Secured the same terms as for 2018
  - The DuraSpace merger with Lyrasis will not affect our relationship with them
- Samvera Annual Report for 2018
  - Available from website and wiki
  - Please share widely –especially with senior colleagues

#### **Occasional tasks**



- Welcoming new people to the Community by receiving and accepting Contributor License Agreements (CLAs)
  - Now more than 300 individual CLAs on file
  - Almost 80 corporate CLAs on file
- Signing up new Samvera Partners
  - University of Utah
  - Ubiquity Press

# Occasional tasks (2)



- Working with the Roadmap Council to put in place a 'turnkey' Docker script for Hyrax alongside the existing one for Hyku
  - For new developers wanting to try our software locally
  - Also improved documentation available
- A Samvera repository of past Connect presentations and posters
  - Marketing exercise to showcase a 'vanilla' product with the message that it can be greatly enhanced
- A visioning exercise to set the tone for Samvera's future path
