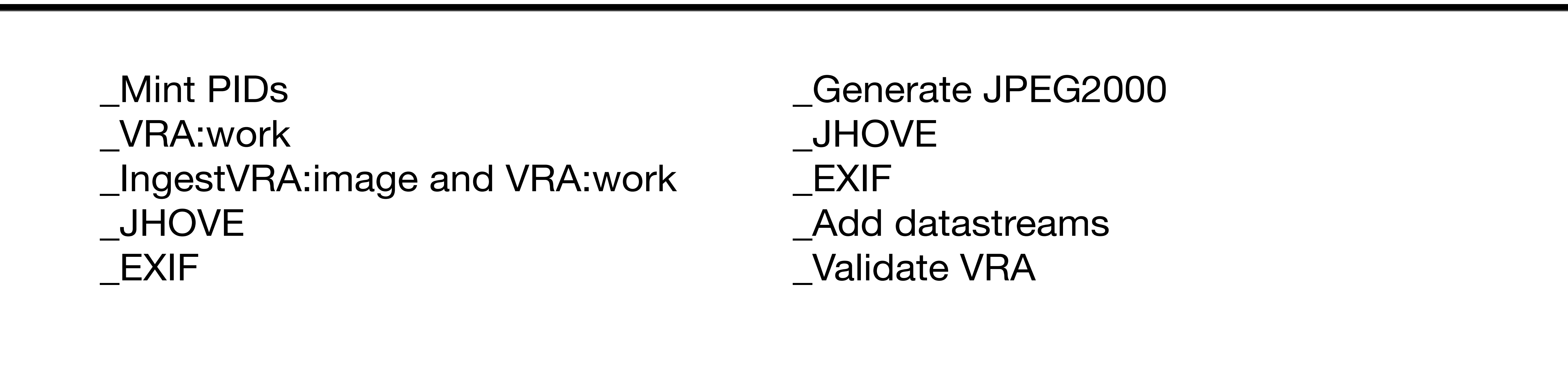
WHY MENU?

Our legacy image ingest process depended upon the transformation of MARC records from an Ex Libris Voyager database. MENU allows for original cataloging in VRA Core 4 metadata, matching the content model of objects in the Repository | Images application. The Repository | Images API now performs the work of the legacy synchronizer.
